Terms and Conditions

By entering the “Win a Pop Top Caravan with *Coxy’s Big Break*” competition, you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions. Entries must comply with these conditions to be valid:

1. STANDARD TERMS

- 1.1 Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

2. WHO CAN ENTER?

- 2.1 Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all residents of Victoria where the Channel Seven or Prime broadcasting signal is received.
- 2.2 Employees and their immediate families of WTFN Entertainment Pty Ltd (the Promoter), Telads Australia Pty Ltd ABN 97 008 002 515 (Telads Australia), Channel Seven Melbourne, the Prime Network and their associated agencies and companies, and related bodies corporate are not eligible to enter.

3. HOW TO ENTER
